1	Internship Program	<p>The Station offers internships in all departments at its radio stations, including promotions, sales, production and programming. The internships continue at varying lengths throughout the calendar year. The interns come from a variety of sources, but most are referred to WFHN/WBSM through the New Bedford Chamber of Commerce, Wareham High School, Bristol Community College, Bridgewater St College, Johnson and Wales University and University of Massachusetts Dartmouth. Information about the internship program is posted on the stations' web sites and distributed through on-air announcements. Most interns are college students and receive college credit for the internships. The Program Director oversees the interns, evaluating their performance and ensuring that they receive the necessary training and education to excel in their position and gain experience in broadcasting. During the reporting period, the Employment Unit had five interns.
